Vacancies

We currently have a vacancy for a Lunchtime Supervisor at St James'. The role is from 11.55-1.10 Monday-Friday, and the pay scale is £7.78/hour. It is expected that all staff at St James' attend regular CPD, which will include attendance at INSET days, and statutory safeguarding and first aid training. Lunchtime Supervisors are expected to act as Play Leaders and support children in their play at lunchtime, as well as provide support with meal times. The ability to maintain confidentiality will be essential, as this role will include access to sensitive information about children. We are also looking to build up a bank of 'cover' staff, to support lunchtimes in the absence of permanent staff. 


